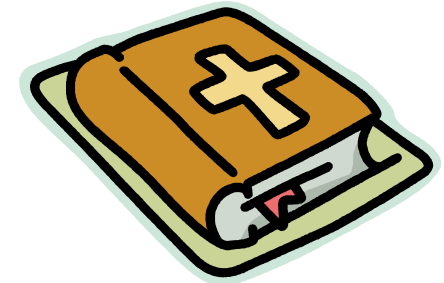

Prayer Requests

1. 1 Timothy 2: 1 & 2 – Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for Kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 2. Forgiveness/Hurts: Please remember to reflect, pray & ask God to search the inner depths of our dealings with our own brothers/sisters in church family or even in our own families. Confess and ask God for forgiveness. (1 John 1: 8-9). **Healing:** We especially pray for healing for those who have been hurt & wounded by any words or actions. We pray that God will reveal to them the source of their hurts and will give them the strength to forgive the ones that have caused the hurt. Pray that they will be released from any strongholds of unforgiveness.

3. Velma/Brandia: Our own Brenda/Velma will be attending camp next week. Please pray for them that this camp will clearly help them and they will see their true value in God's eyes and hunger to know Him better.

4. Don/Charmaine: Don- He is diagnosed with an aneurysm on his aorta. They are on a trip to Alberta for a family reunion. So, please pray for journey mercies, & God's hand & touch upon Don as well as Charmaine.
